

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
ON REALIGNMENT OF BOUNDARIES FOR  
WILKES COUNTY FIRE TAX DISTRICTS  
PURSUANT TO HB349**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Wilkes County Board of Commissioners (hereinafter “the Board of Commissioners”) will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, August 6, 2019, at 6:50 p.m. in the Commissioners' Room at the County Office Building in Wilkesboro, North Carolina, for the purpose of receiving comments on the proposed approval of a Resolution for the realignment of fire tax district boundaries in Wilkes County pursuant to HB349 as approved by the North Carolina General Assembly on July 2, 2019. The Resolution would realign fire tax district boundaries strictly in accordance with the approvals of those maps and designations of parcel ID numbers as were previously agreed to by the Boards of Directors of the respective corporations furnishing fire protection services in Wilkes County and adopted by the Board of Commissioners, as follows:
