


## Payment for Services

## ▶ **Did you know...**

- The Child Health Clinic at the Wilkes County Health Department is open to Wilkes County residents, newborn, to age 21, who have no family physician or medical home.
- We provide sick and well care for children.
- Your child needs a medical home for when:
  - ⇒ He/She looks or acts sick, has a fever, sore throat, or cough.
  - ⇒ For problems that need care now such as infections, injuries, sprains, and minor cuts.
  - ⇒ Check-ups, shots, and help with long-term illnesses.

## Services We Provide

### Well Child Exams

These exams should be completed yearly to insure your child has no medical problems you are unaware of.

### Sports Physicals

Complete sports physicals as required (yearly) by local schools and community organizations.

### Vaccines

Required vaccinations are provided at no cost for children, 18 and under, who meet eligibility guidelines. Parent/guardian will be responsible for all others.

### Vision and Hearing Screenings

Hearing screenings available from birth until the age of 21. Vision screenings beginning at the age of 4 through age 21.

### Dental Varnishing

Dental Varnishing is provided from time of first tooth until 3 1/2 years old.



### Sick Visits

Sick visits are available as needed. Please keep yearly physicals up-to-date in order to guarantee being seen.

### Blood Lead Screenings

Blood lead screenings are provided during physicals beginning at age 1 through age 5 based on state recommendations.

### Developmental Screenings

Developmental screenings begin at 6 months of age through 21 years of age.

### Medical Nutrition Therapy

Nutrition Therapy is specialized one on one counseling with a registered dietitian about using nutrition to control chronic diseases including diabetes and weight management.
