

TEMPORARY FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS

NO PERMIT REQUIRED

An establishment does not need a permit if serving non potential hazardous items: baked goods, popcorn, packaged drinks, snow cones, candied apples, kettle corn, commercially packaged nacho cheese and chips, cotton candy, lemonade, coco and coffee. Additional items could be submitted for consideration.

The following potentially hazardous food that shall not be served are as follows: cream filled pastries and pies, salads such as potato, chicken, ham, and crab.

PERMITTED ESTABLISHMENTS

Submit application with menu, along with \$75 permit fee, within 15 calendar days prior to the date of the event

EXEMPT ESTABLISHMENTS

1. Establishment is Incorporated as a non profit corporation in accordance with Chapter 55A of the General Statutes or
2. Establishment is exempt for federal income tax under the Internal Revenue Code as defined in G.S. 105-228.90 or
3. Establishment is a political committee as defined in G.S.163-278.6

and the organization will not be operating more than once a month for a period not to exceed two (2) consecutive days.

Establishments with a tax exempt number must submit registration form indicating the tax exempt number for the exempt status within 15 calendar days prior to the date of the event.
