

DIRECT TEMPORARY HOUSING

The Road to Receiving a Travel Trailer or Mobile Housing Unit



Step 1

To be considered for direct temporary housing, you must have applied with FEMA.



Step 2

Your damaged home is inspected to determine eligibility for FEMA assistance.



Step 3

If you are found eligible, FEMA will contact you for a pre-placement interview.



Step 4

Site inspection to determine if unit can be placed on your private property.



Step 5

Once your site is approved, FEMA will issue a work order to install a unit.



Step 6

If your site is not approved, FEMA will install a unit at a predetermined commercial park.



Step 7

You arrange for connection of utilities.



Step 8

Your unit is installed and inspected.



After your inspection, you will sign a license-in agreement. Periodically, you will re-certify your need for housing.
